NSE is committed to establishing and maintaining high standards of environmental protection. It will work diligently to meet or exceed its legal responsibilities to protect the environment in accordance with the detected environmental aspects. Policies, procedures, and programs addressing specific environmental issues will be developed and revised as required to ensure compliance with environmental legislation.

This requires all NSE employees to participate in and accept responsibility for achieving the following goals:

- Operation of our facilities in an environmentally sound manner.
- Safe handling of production materials and other related items.
- Conservation and recycling of raw materials and reduction in the amount of waste generated by the company's production processes.
- Prevention of pollution within processes and on the campus grounds.

The company's commitment to these goals includes the following specific elements:

- NSE will maintain compliance programs to inform and train employees in the performance of their duty to fulfill the company's environmental policies.
- Through audits and other means, the company will monitor operations to help assure that practices in our workplace conform to our policies.
